A: Mt Ainslie Summit

Lanterns for sale from 4.45 pm

After the ceremonial welcome, the procession sets off down Mt Ainslie at 6 pm.

B: Aboriginal War Memorial

Paying respect to Aboriginal soldiers and the victims of the frontier wars.

C: Remembrance Nature Park

A rest stop for walkers and a place to join the procession. Community singing and music, brazier fire and candle-light. Lanterns for sale.

Procession sets off again at about 8 pm.

D: Australian War Memorial

Pause for reflection and photographs.

E: Peace Vigil Site

Time for reflection, sharing of stories, music, songs, fire and candle light.

Giving voice to lament and the longing to reorient our nation's attitudes to war.
